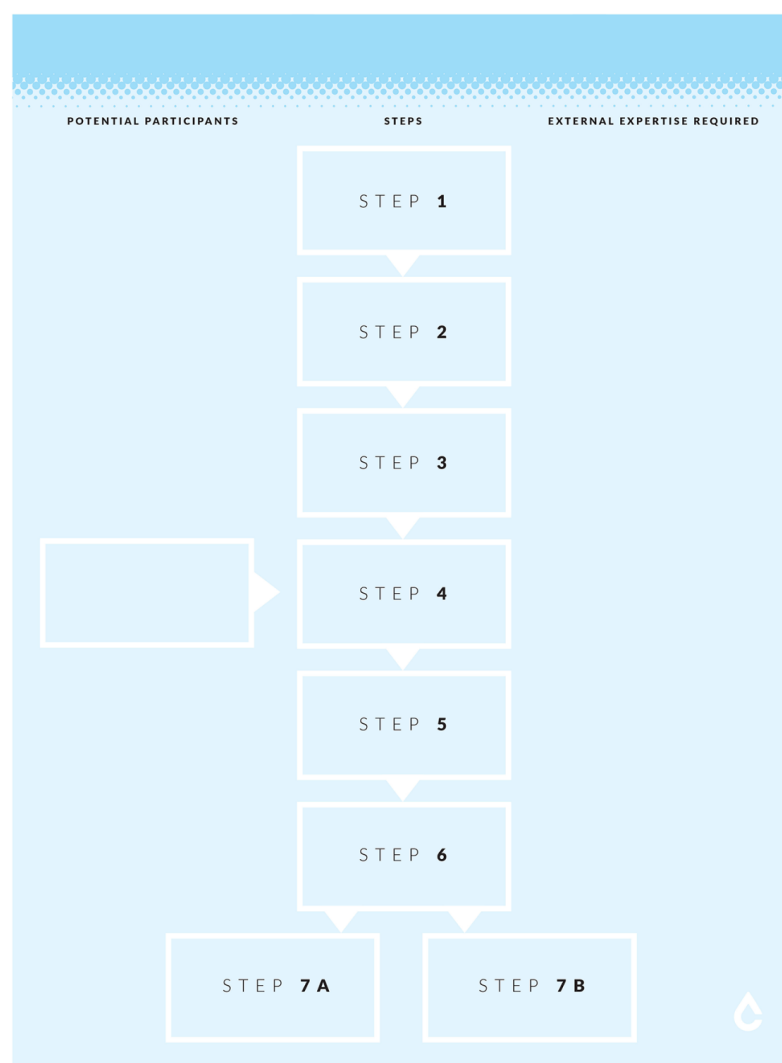
Hold an orientation meeting on the urban sanitation and citywide sanitation planning process with concerned officials and stakeholders

Form a steering committee to drive the sanitation planning

Initiate the citywide sanitation planning process with active engagement of the stakeholders through steering committee leadership

Establish facility/facilities through public-private partnership model

Mobilize a team for detailed designs and budget estimates based on the citywide sanitation plan report



Prioritize interventions and include them in the annual plan and budget

Monitor the operation and management of the facilities

Pool resources from other sources

Organize regular capacity building and awareness activities for all the associated stakeholders

Monitor the operation and management of the facilities
