As we enter 2025, our community stands at an inflection point. We are on the precipice of two major catalysts for DeFi: a shift to a more optimistic regulatory outlook in the US, and the launch of Uniswap v4 and Unichain. A massive opportunity lies ahead for us over the next year.

At times like these, I come back to the reason Ken and I founded the Uniswap Foundation in the first place. **Our vision for the Uniswap Protocol is for it to become the world's infrastructure for digital value transfer. Our vision for the Uniswap community is for it to create, sustain, and propagate immutable software trusted by organizations and individuals globally.**

To achieve this mission, the Uniswap Foundation specifically focuses on Uniswap's technical infrastructure, developers, and governance system. Through our work with developers, we aim to catalyze the next wave of DeFi innovation from within our community. At the same time, we aim to empower Uniswap governance to lead community-led growth, while building resilience and sustainability. Lastly, we pride ourselves on setting a new standard for protocol Foundations, by prioritizing impact-driven grants, transparency, and community alignment.

For 2025, we feel equipped to not just embrace the opportunity of the moment but also redefine what is possible for the Uniswap community. These steps forward will be built upon the strong foundation we established in 2024, detailed in our first annual Report.

The 2024 Community Impact Report highlights our part in leading the growth and activation of the Uniswap developer community, alongside the social and governance infrastructure that sustains them. With this report, we aim to showcase our progress, provide transparency, and to create space for community input as we finalize our roadmap for 2025.

Note from the Uniswap Foundation's Executive Director

Over the last year, the Uniswap Foundation has:

Scaled the Uniswap Developer Community

In 2024, the UF onboarded 800+ v4 developers. This group includes industry executives, noted researchers, university professors, startup founders, and innovative builders from more than 60 countries around the world. More than 150 hooks were created through our programs alone, with applications spanning MEV mitigation and redistribution, real world asset (RWA) onboarding, AI-driven fund management, and more.

Empowered Uniswap Governance

In 2024, the UF launched Govswap, a regular forum for Uniswap delegates to gather IRL to learn from one another, showcase their efforts, and create actionable roadmaps to make a positive impact. We also seeded Conditional Funding Markets for grant allocation, and funded the development of the code for Unistaker, laying the groundwork for governance sustainability.

Developed the Early Unichain Network

Over the last several months, the UF has kickstarted Unichain's developer community. More than 750 builders have registered interest in building onchain thus far. With mainnet on the horizon, 30+ Day 1 integrations and apps have been announced thus far, with more to be made public soon.

As we look forward to 2025, we think about everything that we can build upon this foundation. **Our North Star for 2025 is to create and capture value for Uniswap's stakeholders – its delegates and developers.** To chart the path to Uniswap governance sustainability, and open up new pathways for community-led growth. To build the best home for our developers—a digital space where they can innovate and flourish. We are excited to discuss these goals more with our community in the coming weeks.

The future of DeFi is bright. We are proud to build it alongside you.

Grant making is the primary avenue through which the Uniswap Foundation creates change. Our approach is designed to maximize positive impact, bringing in new contributors to our community who focus on building new initiatives, committees, products, infrastructure, and more.

Over the past year, it has been guided by three core principles:

Scaling Long Term Impact

Our allocation strategy prioritizes larger grants and initiatives to support projects committed to the long-term development of the Uniswap Protocol and its community. This approach is designed to integrate recipients into the Uniswap community for multiple years, to support us in achieving our goals while growing and decentralizing our contributor set.

Stakeholder-centric Grant Design

Our team is focused on different stakeholders across the Uniswap community. We have categories oriented to developers, researchers, and delegates (through our Governance category). Our Security category mitigates risk for our Protocols' users, while Protocol & Innovation focuses on value creation for all.

Clear, Metrics-driven Funding

We define specific success metrics for each grant, with grantees required to track and report progress against these metrics on a quarterly basis. Results are shared with Uniswap Protocol Governance and community bi-annually to ensure transparency and accountability.

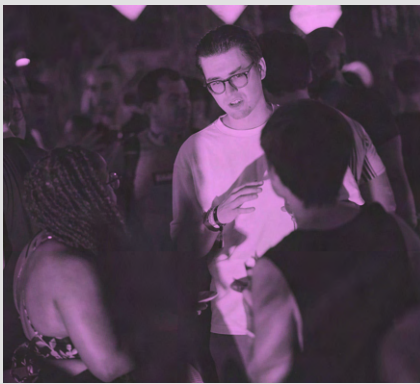

The story of Uniswap is the story of its builders. Over the last year, the Uniswap Foundation has supported individuals and teams as they've driven critical advances across DeFi: from groundbreaking research to novel implementations.



TLDR: Launching the first DeFi Research Fellowship

TLDR (The Latest in DeFi Research) fills a crucial gap in DeFi: empowering engineers, academics, and students to explore new research and develop practical implementations. Led by DeFi's top researchers, the program combines elite mentorship and funding with an annual conference where groundbreaking research shapes the future of DeFi.

Fellows receive a grant, support from research veterans, and a world-class network. Each year, the program culminates in a conference where fellows can showcase their work, and researchers can apply to present their research or software.

TLDR's Fellowship program received 107 applications worldwide, of which 9 fellows were chosen to generate research on [block bidding](#), [ammBoost](#), [ZK fees](#), [transaction fee mechanisms](#), [TEEs](#) and more. These fellows received grants up to \$25,000, mentorship, a speaking slot to present at the conference, a learning stipend, communication coaching and access to monthly workshops featuring experts such as [Dan Robinson](#), [Tarun Chitra](#) and [Andrew Miller](#).

Conference

The inaugural 2024 TLDR Conference at Columbia Business School was a sold-out event that drew nearly 200 attendees from a pool of 400 applicants. The conference featured 26 talks and received 75 research paper submissions. The event attracted top researchers, academics, practitioners, and garnered overwhelming interest from financial organizations, academic institutions, and VC research firms. Multiple side events were independently organized around the TLDR Conference.

Over the next year, key protocol developments, including the launch of Uniswap v4, will further reduce barriers to in-protocol integration and innovation: expanding the design space for developers, and evolving Uniswap from an AMM protocol to a developer platform. As our community grows, a key goal of the Uniswap Foundation is to empower its governance systems to evolve alongside it. To this end, we are pursuing the research, development, and implementation of new governance mechanisms.

One such mechanism is the Conditional Funding Market (CFM). Through [a grant committed to Butter in October 2024](#), we're experimenting with CFMs as a novel tool for Uniswap Protocol Governance to make funding decisions. CFMs leverage an implementation of futarchy, using markets to estimate the probability that a funding decision will produce a desired effect before the funding decision is made. This initiative, the first of its kind in protocol governance, represents the opportunity to more efficiently resource the work of DeFi builders. If our experiments with CFMs are successful, we envision a future where they enable project funding at massive scale, allowing any builder in the world to contribute to the growth of the Uniswap Protocol and get paid the market rate for the impact they create. We look forward to working with [Butter](#) to explore this new frontier.

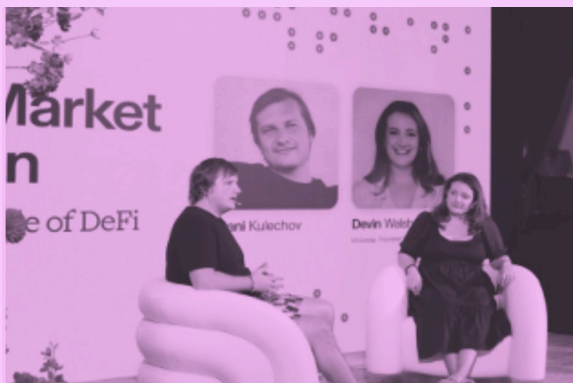
Uniday: Creating the First Uniswap Builder Conference

In 2024, more than 800 new developers joined the Uniswap community. As DeFi expands, it's our goal to create more ways for contributors to connect, learn, and build DeFi's future. Uniday, the Protocol's first large-scale community event, is designed to bring together developers and researchers to map the next era of onchain markets.

In July, we gathered over 100 builders in Brussels for the first edition of Uniday. In November, we united more than 1,000 in collaboration with the [Unichain team](#), [Flashbots](#), and [Edge City](#). Uniday at Devcon featured talks, demos, and workshops from over 30 speakers, including [Vitalik Buterin](#), [DMarz](#), [Karl Floersch](#), [Shea Ketsdever](#), [Erin Koen](#), [Dan Robinson](#), [Kristen Stone](#), [Mark Toda](#), [Mark Tyneway](#), [Jing Wang](#), [Devin Walsh](#), [Chelsy Wu](#), [Tina Zhen](#), and many more.

Uniday also catalyzed critical discussions on Ethereum scaling solutions and DeFi infrastructure advancement: with dedicated sessions on MEV alignment, the future of interoperability, and what's beyond high performance L2s. As we look to 2025, Uniday will play a critical role in our community-driven roadmap: providing space for Uniswap contributors to explore and shape Protocol evolution.

The Uniswap Hook Incubator: Onboarding the Next Generation of DeFi Developers

Since our [initial grant to Atrium Academy in March 2024](#) to launch the Uniswap Hook Incubator (UHI), the program has onboarded over 400 experienced Solidity developers to build v4 hooks. UHI has quickly become a foundational resource for the Uniswap Protocol developer community, offering a free, hands-on, and intensive introduction to developing v4 hooks.

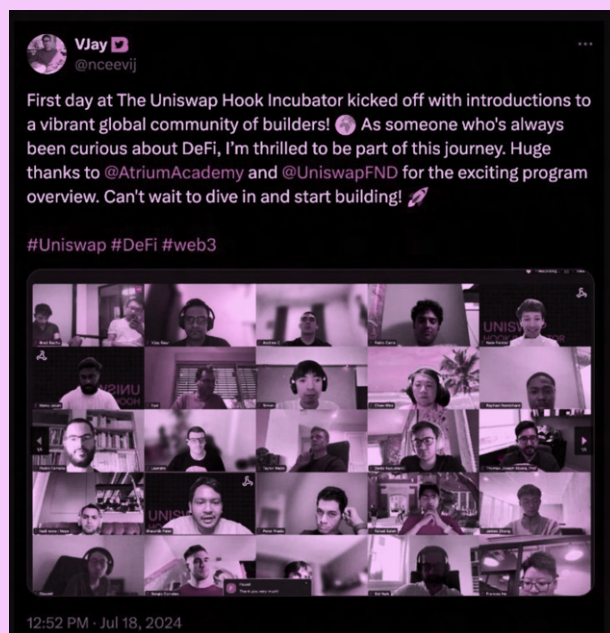
Participants gain a deep understanding of the Protocol, build multiple hooks throughout the cohort, and collaborate directly with an influential network of engineers, VCs, and industry leaders, with capstone projects judged by committees from Arbitrum, Brevis, Chainlink, Eigenlayer, and the Uniswap Foundation.

Graduates of the program have [developed an impressive array of hooks](#) that push what's possible in DeFi, building solutions for loss versus rebalancing (LVR) minimization, index tokens, fee optimization engines, cross-chain mechanisms, advanced trading order types, customizable pricing curves, and much more. In 2025, the program will expand to support new cohorts, with new educational resources and developer events.

The launch of [Uniswap v4](#) represents a key milestone in the evolution of the Uniswap Protocol, unlocking fast, efficient, and expressive AMM innovation, through the introduction of hooks: contracts that customize how pools, swaps, fees, and LP positions interact.

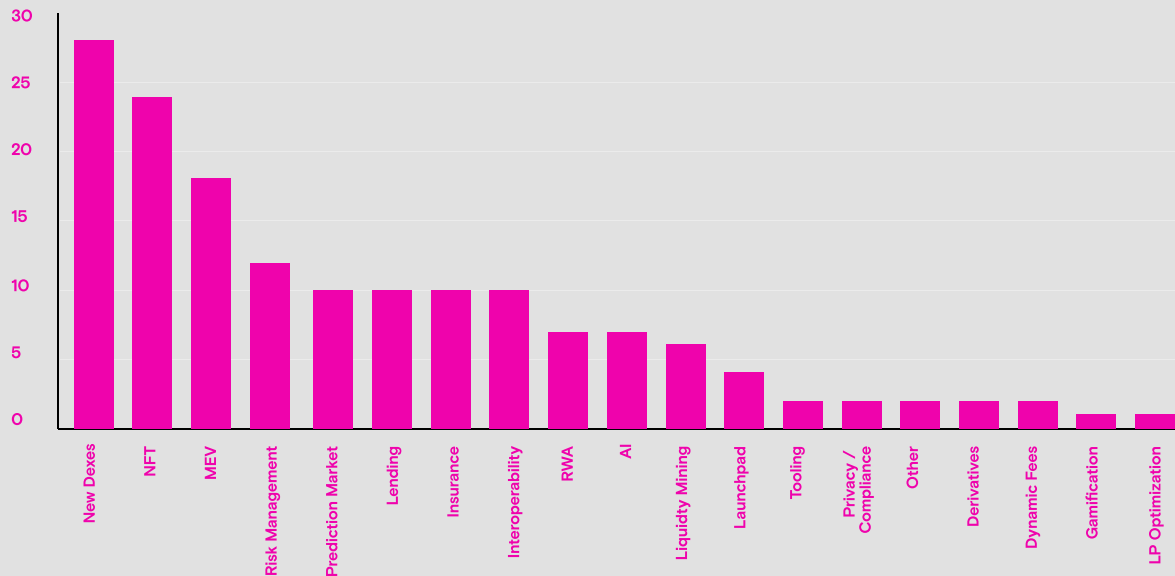
v4 opens up a world of possibilities for how value is created onchain: providing developers with a platform to contribute to, and transform, the future of open financial infrastructure. In 2024, the Uniswap Foundation launched new grants funding initiatives to help accelerate Uniswap v4 builders: onboarding more than 800 new developers, and driving the creation of over 150 v4 hooks. Together, this emergent developer community is driving DeFi innovation; providing new tooling for dynamic fees, attestation, custom liquidity curves, and more.

This funding supported engagements with over **1000 new Uniswap developers** at Uniday and hackathons worldwide, and the **onboarding of 400+ Solidity developers to Uniswap v4**, providing free training to build hooks.

In 2024, we provided a **total grant commitment of \$2,198,908** to seed new DeFi research and its practical implementations. Key initiatives like TLDR (The Latest in DeFi Research) and the Research Summer School Series resulted in the generation of **new research pieces on AMMs, MEV, and Dark Pools**, while driving **engagement with over 620 researchers**, engineers, and academics. **18 new research papers** are currently under development through TLDR, and Allium Labs has made DEX related research simpler through easier data accessibility.

\$1,964,650 was committed to security initiatives in 2024, with the goal to protect the security of Protocol users. Key programs included the facilitation of comprehensive audits for Uniswap v4, the launch of community bug bounty competitions, and upgrades to the security of Uniswap's governance smart contracts.
