## WORD

**READ:** Psalm 103:1-12

From this passage – 5 things we should never forget as a Christian:

1. He forgives all your sins.
2. He heals all your diseases.
3. He redeems your life from destruction.
4. He crowns your life with loving kindness and tender mercies.
5. He satisfies your mouth with good things.

**TODAY** – Focus on:

**He forgives ALL your sins – a full pardon!**

Sickness is a consequence of sin – not YOUR sin.

The consequences of sin:

- Separation from God.
- Sickness and disease.
- Financial poverty.

**A. We all deserved to die for our sins.**

**READ:** Romans 6:23 (NKJV) & Romans 3:23 (NKJV)

Fact: We have all fallen short of God's standards, none of us are able to keep all the commandments of God – We all deserve to die for our sins.

**B. What did Jesus do for us on the cross?**

**READ:** Romans 3:24-26 (NKJV) & 2 Corinthians 5:21

**Discussion in smaller groups:**

- What does it mean to be 'justified'?  
(to be made 'just as if I had never sinned')
- What does 'righteousness' mean?

*(to be in right standing with God)*

- What does it mean that Jesus was a ‘propitiation’?  
*(Jesus is the one who satisfied God’s wrath, He satisfied the judgement of God **on our behalf**)*

### **B. Salvation is a free gift.**

**READ:** John 3:16 & Ephesians 2:8-9

#### **Discussion in smaller groups:**

- Can our good works (going to church, giving money to the poor, helping people) get us saved and right with God?
- How then do we get saved?

Lead discussion to:

- *It is God’s goodness that brings us to repentance – acknowledging your sin before God and then you receive forgiveness.*
- *We are saved by grace (God treating us better than what we deserve)*
- *We are saved through faith (Believing in what Jesus did for us on the cross)*

### **C. We receive forgiveness for our sins.**

When we receive salvation (get saved), we receive forgiveness of ALL our sins.

**READ:** 1 John 1:7; Colossians 1:14, 2:13-14; Ephesians 4:32

***“We all deserved the death penalty – but God’s grace gave us a FULL PARDON!” – Ps At***

You are now righteous before God.

- Your righteousness is a gift from God, not your own righteousness, but His righteousness.

Forgiveness is a free gift that you receive by faith!

***“Sometimes we have more faith in our transgressions than in the blood of Jesus.” – Ps At***

### **D. We receive the power to live free from guilt and shame.**

Last week we discussed:

When Jesus enters the room there is:

- Power for salvation.
- Power to live free from sin.

**Explain the analogy of the confession booth used on Sunday.**

*Many Christians think they need to hide from God when they do something wrong. They go into the confession booth and hide in the dark from God, because they think God is angry with them. And depending on how 'big' or 'small' their sin, the longer they remain in the booth behind the curtain in guilt and shame.*

***But Jesus came to set us free from the shame and guilt of our sins!***

**READ:** Hebrews 10:14; Romans 8:1 & Philippians 3:13

### Discussion in smaller groups:

- Hebrews 10:14 - What did Jesus do on the cross for us?  
*(He has already made us perfect before our Father)*
- Romans 8:1 – What does it mean that God does not condemn us?
- Philippians 3:13 – What does Paul instruct us to do?  
*(Forget our past – to not even think of our past, for God has removed our sins as far from us as the East is from the West)*

***“If God, the holy God, has forgave you, who are you to not forgive yourself?”  
– Ps At***

### **Come on! Don't walk around carrying that invisible cloud of sin, guilt, and shame!**

- God has already forgiven you! He has given you a full pardon!
- And until you do not forgive yourself you will never live free from sin.

### **E. What if I sin again?**

#### **Discussion:**

- Does it mean that now that we are saved, we will not sin?

**READ:** 1 John 1:8-10 & 1 John 2:1-2

Lead the discussion to:

- We will still sin, but we know we are already forgiven.
  - The blood of Jesus is working now – washing us clean from all unrighteousness.
- When we sin – we have an ADVOCATE – not a judge.
  - When God now looks at us, He sees us through what Jesus did on the cross for us.
  - Our advocate applies our 'Full pardon' before our Father!
- When we repent (acknowledge) and confess our sins before God – we are cleansed from all unrighteousness.

**On Easter you don't need a sacrifice – the ultimate sacrifice – Jesus – was already made!**

## **WORKS**

**Play a worship song** (Nothing but the blood of Jesus)

Facilitate a time of worship and encourage homecell members to firstly lay down any guilt and shame and to take hold of the FULL PARDON that God has for each of them. Allow homecell members to minister to one another after having their own personal moment with God. Remind everyone that once things are laid at the foot of the cross, to leave it there... no need to revisit it unless you're using it as a testimony to guide others to their victory and freedom.
