READ: Matthew 6:33 & John 4:34

Discussion: Discuss in smaller groups,

- What does it mean to “seek first”?
- Practically what does it mean to seek first the “kingdom and His righteousness”?
- What is the “will of the Father”?

“Your job is important for through it you will fulfil your purpose.”

1. YOU matter to God

God loves you.

You matter to God.

- Seek Him above all else

Your job, your family, your finances, your health, your hopes and dreams matter to God.

Are you busy with God’s purpose?

Your title and position means nothing if you are not rooted in Christ and busy with God's purpose.

2. PEOPLE matter to God.

READ: John 3:16

- You matter to God!
- Your world matters to God! (“God so loved the world...”)

READ: Matthew 9:18-38

- The woman with the issue of blood - matters to God.
- The man whose child died - matters to God.
- The child who just died – matters to God.
- The two blind men outside that followed Jesus – matters to God.
- The mute man – matters to God.

Jesus travelled through the towns and villages (vv.35-38)

- He healed every kind of sickness.
- He had compassion on the crowd – for the people in the crowd matter to God.

ALL people matter to God!

Jesus came to:

- Lift humanity, to restore people, to fix people's lives, to heal people.
- Jesus will never leave you where He found you.

Discussion: Let 1 or 2 people in each smaller group share their testimony (2-3min) of God lifted them, restored them, fixed their lives, etc.

3. We are to be Jesus' hands and feet in our world.

READ: Romans 10:14-15

How will people hear about the Gospel without a preacher?

There is no such thing as a silent witness.

You are Christ's ambassador.

Discussion: What does it mean to be an ambassador?

Lead the discussion to:

- *You represent God in every situation and conversation.*

- You are placed wherever you are (at work, at home, in your family, at school or university) to **bring the Gospel to people!**
- An ambassador ALWAYS represents – not only when they feel like it.

“Love them without acting like them for their soul’s matter!”

When people come into your house.

- You have the responsibility to share your faith with them – even to the point of offending them.

“You cannot love people and keep the Gospel from them”

Your faith will cause division.

READ: Matthew 10:34-36

Discussion: Discuss in smaller groups,

- What if people reject the Gospel when you tell them?
- What if people don’t want to hear about God when you tell them?
- Are you doing something wrong?
- Does this mean you should stop?

When people hear the Gospel, they will either:

- Accept it – and come to church with you.
- Reject it – they are not rejecting you, they are rejecting what God did.
- **Each person must make a decision when they hear the Gospel!**

“Stop trying to be popular and share the Gospel with people!”

Example: The two thieves on the cross with Jesus – divided – one accepted and one rejected Him.

WORKS

**Are you committed to being a fisher of men?
Even when you ‘catch’ nothing – are you committed?**

People matter ALL the time to God – not just when it suites you.

FOCUS ON THE OIKOS LIST

Pastor At said the following:

- Risk losing the friendship by sharing the Gospel with them.
- For if you do not share the Gospel you risk their eternity.

Who on your 'Oikos list' will you share the Gospel with this week?

God's Word never returns void.

READ: Isaiah 55:11

- People may be offended with the Gospel today
- But the Word never returns void – it will eventually yield fruit.

Whom do you need to share the Gospel with AGAIN this week?

You are Christ's Ambassador

- Are you representing God in every area of your life?
- Are there certain things in your life that you have to deny yourself for you to be an ambassador to Christ?
 - If yes, then make a commitment to lay them down at God's feet and commit to represent God in every area of your life – so that **people in your life can be saved!**

Play a worship song – In worship,

- pray for your Homecell and ask God to give each member an understanding and fresh revelation of their purpose – to win the lost at any cost.
- Encourage the members to lay down the things in their life that does not represent God – so they may be a more effective witness for God.
