WORD

READ: 1 Corinthians 15:57-58 TPT

Our victory is assured through Christ.

READ: 1 John 4:4, 1 John 5:4 & Romans 8:31, 35

The battle has already been won.

We fight from a place of victory – to enforce the devil’s defeat.

READ: Romans 8:37 in translations: HCSB, GNT, MSG, NIRV, NLT

The battle has already been won – and the enemy is a defeated foe.

“God says ‘Thanks be to God who ALWAYS gives us the victory! And my brother ‘ALWAYS’ means always!”

Discussion: Discuss together:

Does this mean we do not have to do anything? We can just sit and be victorious?

Lead the discussion to: God has already given us the victory,

- does not mean we will not face trials in this world.
- but we have to show up on the battlefield and
- enforce the enemy’s defeat – because we HAVE THE VICTORY!

God even promises that He will lead us on a victory parade.

READ: 2 Corinthians 2:14 MSG

“God will show up in the fire. God will shut the lion’s mouth. God is going to open the prison doors and those shackles are going to come off. God is going to sustain you, God is with you.”

Trials and tribulations are a part of life – God has already promised the VICTORY!

The question is:

“How do I come through?”

1. Don't ask the Lord, 'Why me?'

Sometimes life just happens! Then we should not ask questions like:

- Why me Lord?
- What did I do wrong?
- Where did I open a door?

These questions take you to a place of guilt and condemnation.

These questions will rob you of your confidence before God.

READ: 1 Corinthians 10:13 TPT, 1 Peter 4:12-13 MSG, 2 Corinthians 12:9

Discussion:

Discuss and write down the promises of God to each believer when facing a challenge.

2. Never doubt God's intention toward you.

READ: James 1:2-8, 12-17

Take note: the word “*temptation*” in this passage means:

- Test, trial, or tribulation.

Verse 2-8: Remain dependant on God – reliant on His grace.

Verses 12-17: Settle it in your heart:

- God's intention toward you are only good. To lift you and expand you.
- God is not the one testing you with evil – evil being the temptation to quit.
- God is not the cause of your tribulations – but He is orchestrating your deliverance.
- His will and intentions toward you – IS GOOD – and it never changes!
- God promised the VICTORY and that settles it!

3. Worship God

READ: Philippians 4:4, 6-7 & Habakuk 3:17-19

- Pray, pray and & pray in tongues.
- Rejoice in God always.
- Worship God.

Example of Job

READ: Job 2:7-10, James 5:11 and then Job 42:10-17

Discussion: Job was a man who was blameless before God. Job lost everything in one day – his flocks, his possessions, his children. And then he lost his health.

Discuss what Job did when he lost everything, and discuss how God restored him double-fold.

Show through the above example that Job:

1. Did not ask God 'Why me?'
2. Did not question God's intentions toward Him.
(It was satan who struck him with boils – verse 7 and James 5:11)
3. Job worshipped God.
God restored double-fold what Job lost.

WORKS

From Job's example we saw that when challenges came - he **worshipped God**.

Discuss the importance of getting yourself into the presence of God by:

(Let the members share the impact and practical ways)

- Coming to Church every Sunday.
- Coming to Homecell every week.
- Reading your Bible every day.
- Praying in the Spirit every day.
- Worshipping God every day.

Baptise people in the Holy Spirit within the Homecell – if they want to receive the gift of tongues.

Encourage the members to pray for one another for strength and wisdom on the battlefield, to keep on fighting because

GOD has ALREADY given them the VICTORY!
