### **WELCOME**

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell.

### **WORSHIP**

Prepare Praise and Worship for the Homecell gathering (1 Praise & 1 Worship song)

#### WORD

Ask a few cell members to read John 4:14, John 7:37b-38, & Proverbs 4:23

**QUESTION 1:** The past few weeks Ps At has been sharing on some principles we need to apply if we would like to experience God's overflow during 2024. How do these 3 scriptures relate to the promise of overflow?

Answer: It's God's desire for each of us to overflow in every aspect of our life.

Overflow will always flow from within us... God working within us. We need to guard our heart and inner life. We must also get rid of whatever can stop the waters of overflow from flowing from our inner most being.

**QUESTION 2:** Why would you say people pay so little attention to what's happening in their heart?

The devil would like nothing more than to block, pollute, clog up your inner wells and stop God's overflow in your life.

Ps At Boshoff

Ask a cell member to read Genesis 26:1-6

**QUESTION 3:** In the natural, things were not looking good for Isaac. He was amid a severe famine. Why on earth did he decide to stay in that land when there were clearly better opportunities available elsewhere?

Answer: Isaac had a clear word from God: '...dwell in the land...' If we want to experience God's overflow in our life, we must make sure we have a clear word from God and then we must be obedient to God's word.

Ask a cell member to read Genesis 26:12-33

**QUESTION 4:** Isaac did not only face opposition in the form of a severe famine, but he also faced opposition from people he previously trusted and had a relationship with. What do we learn about Isaac's character in how he dealt with this opposition?

# **HOMECELL NOTES**

Answer: Isaac never allowed the sabotage and opposition of people to taint who he was. He knew he was blessed of God! The moment they tried to stop him; he just went on to dig another well.

Family, we cannot allow what people do to get to us on the inside. It is then that we become clogged on the inside with bitterness, anger, and resentment. The result: the waters of overflow will no longer flow.

Ps At Boshoff

On Sunday Pastor At spoke about 5 wells which Isaac was confronted with:

1. **JEALOUSY** – look again at Genesis 26:14

**QUESTION 5:** What would you say is the driving force behind jealousy?

Answer: Jealousy is usually the result of a dept-to-debtor dynamic that always causes an imbalance in any relationship. Jealousy's attitude is "somebody owes me." Jealousy is usually the result of thinking about the things others have that you lack. We assume our problem is with the person who possesses what we lack. But let's face it; God could have fixed all that, but He decided to skip you! So, you're actually mad with God. Jealousy says: "God owes me!"

ESEK - "Strife" that produces arguments. Envy always brings strife, and strife brings contention and division.

Ask a few cell members to read Proverbs 14:30: Proverbs 26:21: 1 Corinthians 11:16

 SITNAH – "Accusation." Jealousy, causing strife, will always lead to false accusations.

Ask a cell member to read Romans 12:17-21

- 4. **REHOBOTH** "Room enough." Eventually Isaac digs a well that no one quarrels over, and he names it Rehoboth, saying, "Now the Lord has given us room and we will flourish in the land."
- 5. **SHEBAH** "Restoration." Shebah, means "seven" or "oath." The Lord will cause your enemies to restore back seven times what has been stolen from you.

If you guard your heart and just keep on digging... you too will hit overflow!
