## WORD

Ask a few homecell members to read Psalm 30:1-5 & v11-12; Isaiah 61:1-3

**QUESTION 1:** We have the saying, “*Every dark cloud has a silver lining.*” David says in Psalms 30 that he has an expectation for God to turn things around. What should our expectation be when we go through a tough season in our life?

*Answer: When we go through a tough season, we need to focus on that which God promised! We, with confidence, can expect an exchange, just as God promised in Isaiah 61:3.*

**QUESTION 2:** Why do you think many people, when they go through some storms in life, quickly come to the conclusion that they have a bad life?

**Don't ever judge your future by the storms you face today.  
Don't allow a bad day to make you believe you are having a bad life.  
Don't allow delays to make you believe you were denied.**

Ask a few cell members to read John 16:33 The Passion Translation, James 1:2, 3 & Romans 8:28

**QUESTION 3:** These passages hold the keys to how we should deal with storms? What do you learn from these passages?

*Answer: 1. Storms are an undeniable part of life & part of our human experience. We should not be surprised when storms show up in our life.  
2. Jesus said that He concurred the world... this gives us hope that no storm is unconquerable through Christ.  
3. We have the assurance that no matter what happens in our life, it will eventually work out for the good.*

### **2 Corinthians 4:8-9 Message Bible**

*We've been surrounded and battered by troubles, but we're not demoralized; we're not sure what to do, but we know that God knows what to do; we've been spiritually terrorized, but God hasn't left our side; we've been thrown down, but we haven't broken.*

Ask a few cell members to read 2 Corinthians 4:13, 16, 18; Genesis 50:20; Proverbs 3:5-6; Psalm 138:8; James 5:11

**QUESTION 4:** Why do you think it is of critical importance that we believe in God's good intention towards our lives?

*Answer: If we become uncertainty about God's intention for our life, we will find it nearly impossible to trust Him. If we don't trust God, it will be impossible to activate your faith.*

On Sunday Pastor At reminded us of the following 3 things:

## 1. KEEP HOPE ALIVE IN YOUR HEART

**QUESTION 5:** How would you define hope?

*Answer: Hope is a positive expectation of a favorable outcome. The opposite to hope is a cynical, negative attitude.*

**We need to keep hope alive because hope anchors your soul!**

*I know what I'm doing. I have it all planned out—plans to take care of you, not abandon you, plans to give you the future you hope for.*

## 2. HAVE FAITH IN GOD

Ask a few cell members to read Mark 11:22-24; Hebrews 10:35-38 & Hebrews 11:6

Have faith in God:

- ... in His Word
- ... in His love
- ... in His ability

## 3. REJOICE

Ask a few cell members to read Nehemiah 8:10; Philippians 4:4-6; Habakkuk 3:17-19
