WORSHIP

WORD

Genesis 1:1-5 The Living Bible

¹ When God began creating the heavens and the earth, ² the earth was a shapeless, chaotic mass, with the Spirit of God brooding over the dark vapors. ³ Then God said, "Let there be light." And light appeared. ⁴⁻⁵ And God was pleased with it and divided the light from the darkness. He called the light "daytime," and the darkness "nighttime." Together they formed the first day.

QUESTION 1: How would you define 'chaos'?

DEFINITION (Websters dictionary): *a state of utter confusion and disorder*

QUESTION 2: Have you ever experienced a chaotic situation. How well do you deal with chaos? Why do you think chaos goes against our human nature? Why is it that chaos disturbs our heart, mind and spirit?

QUESTION 3: Here we see God create a new, beautiful world out of total chaos and darkness. What does this say about God's nature?

Answer: God is not a God of disorder and confusion. God has the ability to, with one word, change chaos to order. God has the power to transform any and every chaotic situation in your life to order.

If you want to see *supernatural acceleration* then every form of chaos must be brought to Kingdom order, starting in your personal life. You will accomplish this by exercising the dominion God gave you!

Ask a cell member to read Genesis 1:26-28

QUESTION 4: According to this piece of scripture, what would you say was the tool God gave Adam to bring and maintain order in his life and world?

Answer: The first thing God gave Adam after He created him, was dominion.

QUESTION 5: In a Biblical context, what would you say does it mean to have dominion?

HOMECELL NOTES

Answer: Dominion implies: control, supremacy, and dominance. We were created not to be subdued, but to subdue circumstances, adversity, chaos etc. God created us in his likeness and image for rulership.

Ask a few cell members to read 1 John 5:4-5 The Passion Translation; 1 John 4:4; Psalm 8:1-9; Luke 19:13

Psalms 8:5-8 The Passion Translation

⁵ Yet what honor you have given to men, created only a little lower than Elohim, crowned with glory and magnificence. ⁶ You have delegated to them rulership over all you have made, with everything under their authority, placing earth itself under the feet of your image-bearers. ⁷⁻⁸ All the created order and every living thing of the earth, sky, and sea—the wildest beasts and all that move in the paths of the sea — everything is in submission to Adam's sons.

QUESTION 6: If we, as image-bearers of God, have been created for rulership, what is our practical responsibility?

*Answer: 1. This is our time to take over, to rule and reign in this life through Jesus Christ.
2. To bring God's Kingdom order to our world; shaping the culture, education, economy, political arena, arts, moral values, bringing social justice and alleviate poverty and suffering.
3. We should become the reformers of society.
4. We are called to shape a beautiful world out of the present chaos, where our children will have a future and a hope.*

Ask a few cell members to read Micah 4:1-2; Daniel 2:44; Isaiah 2:2

QUESTION 7: These passages are all prophetic declarations regarding God's Kingdom during the last days. The church is the physical manifestation of God's Kingdom here on earth. What role will the church play in establishing God's Kingdom order?

Answer: The church must be the salt of the earth and the light of the world. As members of the church, we must work against every form of decay and every form of darkness.

WORKS

2 Corinthians 5:20 The Passion Translation

We are ambassadors of the Anointed One who carry the message of Christ to the world, as though God were tenderly pleading with them directly through our lips. So, we tenderly plead with you on Christ's behalf, "Turn back to God and be reconciled to him."
