

Activity report EBU Ethics Committee

The EBU Ethics Committee (EEC) consists of three members: Lilla Feldmann, Jake Lyne, Michael Ritman.

We are taking on complaints about inappropriate behaviour between (delegates of) members of EBU. Our reference for this is the EBU Code of Ethics.

Also, we take on complaints from outsiders, if they point at inappropriate behaviour within our member organisations, and if our assessment is that the complaint is substantial and needs to be addressed. Our reference for this is the EBU Ethics Protocol.

Our handling of any complaint is confidential; we will not share any information relating to a complaint, not even with other council members.

Based on our handling of a complaint we may make a recommendation to the EBU Council for their follow-up.

We are constantly looking for new members of the EEC, people with relevant qualifications and/or experience. Please look in your own organisations if you can find and motivate people to join us.

In the past year we have handled three different complaints.
