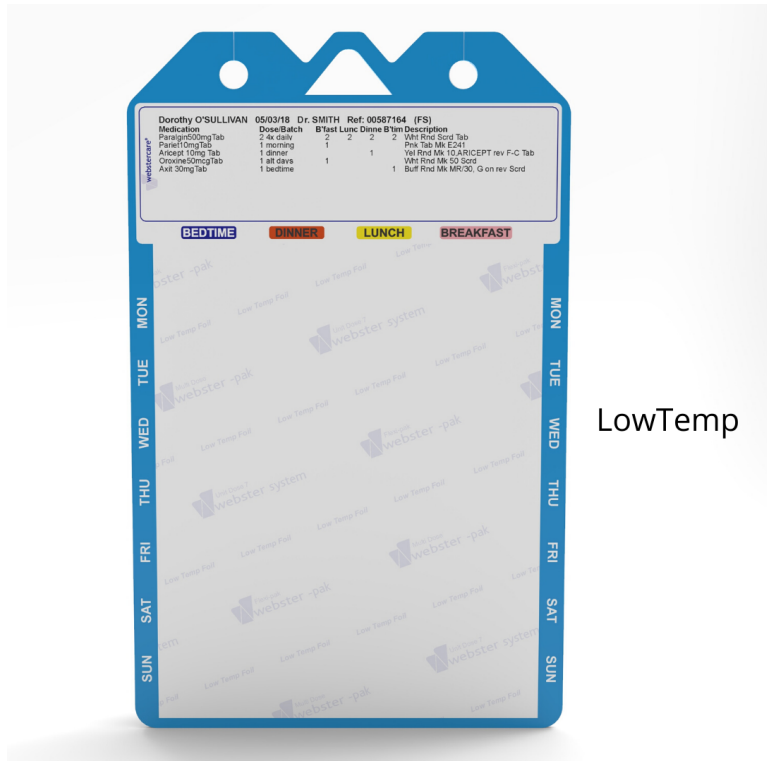
Medication should empower, not overwhelm. Webster Packs help ensure you or your loved ones stay on track with meeting your health needs - because every dose matters!
