LANDMINES

Antipersonnel landmines are explosive devices designed to be detonated by a person's presence, proximity, or contact. Placed under or on the ground, they can lie dormant for years, threatening

civilians' safety during conflicts and long afterward.

A landmine is incapable of distinguishing between a soldier or a child stepping on it, therefore they indiscriminately

kill or injure civilians, aid workers, peacekeepers, and soldiers alike. Nobody knows how many mines are in the ground worldwide. It is believed that there may be over 100 million in over 70 countries.
