

Assistant Athletic Director, Part-Time (20 hours a week)

This position also comes with an opportunity to run summer camps/auxiliary programs and to coach for at least one season (preferably Fall or Spring varsity sport/intramural sport).

The successful candidate will be a dynamic presence who demonstrates a genuine and infectious passion for the mission of the School, an understanding of the value of single-gender education, and has the capacity to align with the School's core values.

Responsibilities for Assistant Athletic Director:

- Assist with the logistical needs and goal-setting of the Miss Hall's Athletic Program, in collaboration with and in support of the Director of Athletics
- Be knowledgeable of academic, social, wellness, and physical well-being of student-athletes by reviewing pertinent documents related to student life at MHS
- Communicate all updates regarding operational needs at home and away games, schedule/calendaring changes, transportation needs, and culinary needs to coaches, culinary staff, and student-athletes
- Confirm officials, transportation, and staffing for home games
- Create and maintain attendance lists/rosters for coaches for practices and games
- Gather and report contest scores and outcomes to the School's website and/or social media in a timely manner
- Prepare for and attend the end-of-season banquet
- Attend all department meetings as necessary/determined by the Athletic Director
- Assist with the planning and execution of Blue/Gold and other athletic spirit events for the year
- Serve as representative of the Athletic Department when Athletic Director is off site
- Research and report on trends and best practices within the field of athletics
- Abide by the New England Prep School Athletic Council (NEPSAC) Code of Ethics and Conduct
- Interact with students, colleagues, consultants, and members of the public in a courteous and respectful manner
- Maintain an active presence and participate fully in campus life by attending school events and participating in recreational activities when possible



Qualifications

- Associate Degree required; Bachelor's Degree preferred
- Minimum 2 years' experience preferred as administrative support
- Ability to drive the School's vehicles (vans and 14-passenger buses); training will be provided
- Certification in CPR/AED and First Aid preferred
- Coaching experience and ability to coach a team sport for one season (varsity or intramural)
- Availability to work Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday each week
- Excellent administrative and organizational skills, including the ability to prioritize and complete tasks by established deadlines
- Experience in developing practice plans and providing individual and team instruction
- Critical thinking and troubleshooting skills, with strong electronic media literacy
- Experience in or a keen interest in teaching and coaching female student-athletes
