



Per Diem Substitute Ceramics Teacher

Position Overview

Miss Hall's is seeking a per diem substitute teacher to teach two courses of Ceramics I/II starting in January 2023 and on an as-needed basis. Responsibilities will include:

- Teaching classes that meet Tuesdays and Fridays between 8:30 and 3:30 p.m.
- Supporting 28 students with their on-going projects in hand-building and wheel throwing
- Supporting each student as they select a piece and write a statement to be included in the Winter Art Show in February 2023
- Holding students accountable for caring for the materials, projects, and clean-up
- Conducting bisque and glaze firings as needed
- Communicating with Facilities team about any maintenance needed in the Ceramics Studio
- Communicating with Department Chair about any needs regarding classroom management and individual student needs
