



Scenic/Lighting Designer and Technical Director

Position Overview

Miss Hall's is seeking a Scenic/Lighting Designer and Technical Director for our Drama productions. This position entails working with the Director of Theater program to design the sets and lights for 3 productions each academic year (one musical, one drama, and one student-devised piece).

Responsibilities will include:

- Plan the technical build of the scenery and work with students to build it.
- Work with the Director to find and create prop items for each production.
- Put together the lighting system and rent/install lighting equipment needed for each production.
- Hire professional stage technicians to assist in hanging and focusing lights for production.
- Teach students to run the production, which includes, but is not limited to: scene changes, operating the lighting & sound consoles, running follow spots and working with the student stage manager to call the show cues.
- Plan and oversee the strike of each production using a combination of a student crew with some professionals to help with the lighting equipment.
- Maintain the stock collection of platforms, flats, stair units, props, and other stock pieces.
- Keep up with all safety requirements to ensure that each production is done safely and meets all current codes and regulations.

Qualifications

- This person or persons will have the technical skills necessary for the tasks and the ability and willingness to engage high school students in the work.
