MHS Athletics Policy (For Home and Opponent)

For purposes of this policy, fully vaccinated means: it has been two weeks, 14 days, since Johnson & Johnson vaccine dose; it has been two weeks, 14 days, since second Moderna or Pfizer vaccine dose. If you have only only received one out of the two vaccine doses, you are not considered to be fully vaccinated and must comply with any and all guidelines set forth for unvaccinated visitors to MHS. Thank you for abiding by these policies as we all work together for the Common Good of our communities!

- 1. All athletes (team managers), coaches, spectators, other essential personnel (trainers, nurses, etc) will wear masks indoors, regardless of vaccination status.
- 2. We require everyone to wear a mask indoors. Fully vaccinated athletes and team members may be unmasked outdoors.
- 3. All spectators must be masked both inside and outside.
- 4. MHS is requiring all teams we play/all opponents to be vaccinated or have negative test results (rapid test acceptable).
- Spectators/visitors for both MHS and opponents must follow MHS Common Good Guidelines of being masked, practicing social distancing, using hand sanitizer, and not attending game if symptomatic or has been tested positive of COVID-19 within 90 days.
- 6. Team benches and shared sporting equipment will be sanitized throughout the duration of the game. MHS team managers will be responsible for sanitizing the MHS bench at home and away games. Opponents will be responsible for sanitizing their bench throughout home games. MHS will provide sanitizing wipes for opponents at home games.
- 7. There will be benches for players to ensure social distancing of 3 ft. For spectators in bleachers, seating will be marked off to ensure social distancing of 3 ft. For volleyball games, spectators sit in bleachers socially distanced.
- 8. Whenever possible during an inside game/game held in Thatcher Gym, MHS will leave open doors and windows to assist with air circulation and flow.
- 9. All opponents and visiting teams' spectators will abide by MHS guidelines.
