Thank you so much for participating in our recent student survey. It is very helpful for us to hear your perspective about how the year is going. During our faculty meeting, we reviewed the results and discussed a few themes that came to the forefront for us.

Students are finding the classes interesting and are working hard to stay engaged and motivated. Some students have shared that they would like to be more connected with classmates while learning from a distance and it can be challenging managing time when there is less class time and more independent coursework. You all shared strategies that have worked for you and below are some suggestions that come from our students and faculty.

- Check in with a friend, find a study buddy, connect with a family member if you are feeling stuck.
- Join a club, create a study break group, reach out to a friend.
- Check in with teachers and academic support (peer tutor, ASC, Math/Science/ Writing Center), use teachers' office hours, use your advisor as a resource
- Make sure to take breaks, change locations, plan free time, and use a timer to budget your work time, plan a reward after finishing your work (t.v. show, nap, etc.).

During these next weeks, teachers and advisors will be reflecting on ways that they can best support your connections and present assignments in a way that facilitates your efforts to use time effectively. We will continue to survey students throughout the year and use the information to continually improve your learning experiences.
