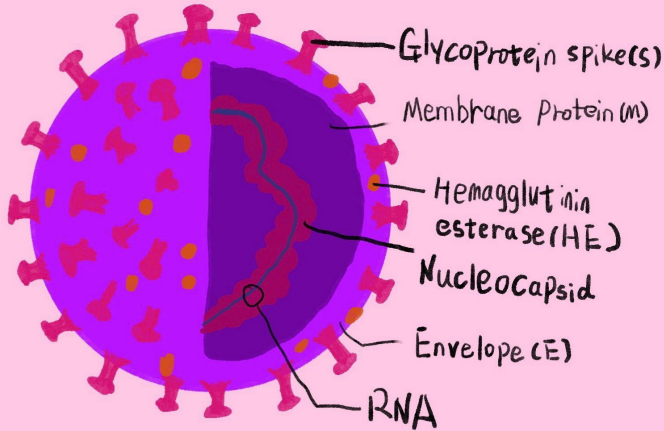


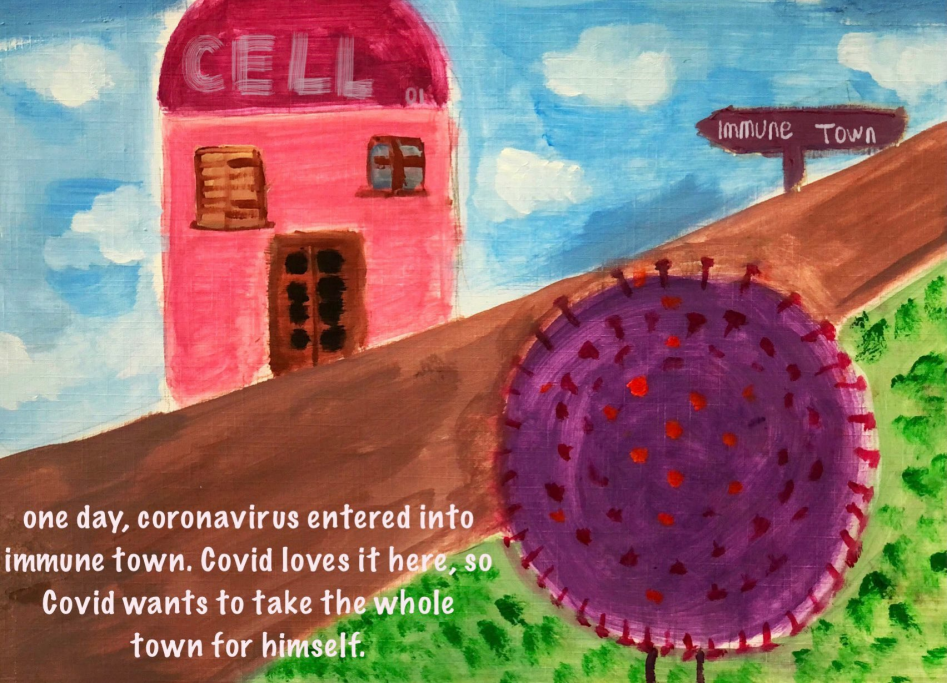
A Crisis in Immune Town

town for himself.

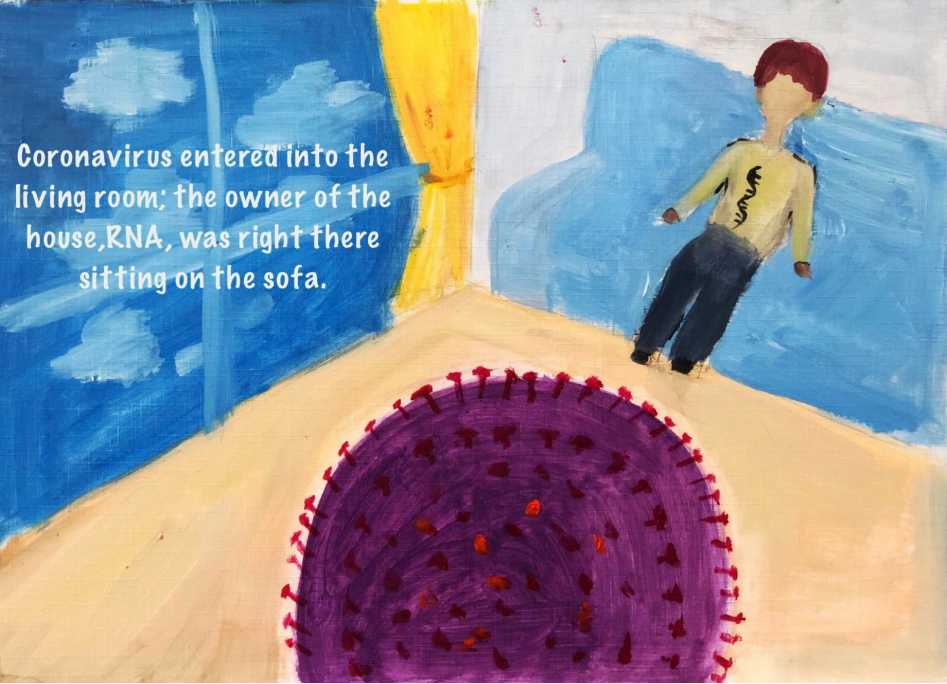


Coronavirus visited the

Covid friends like him.

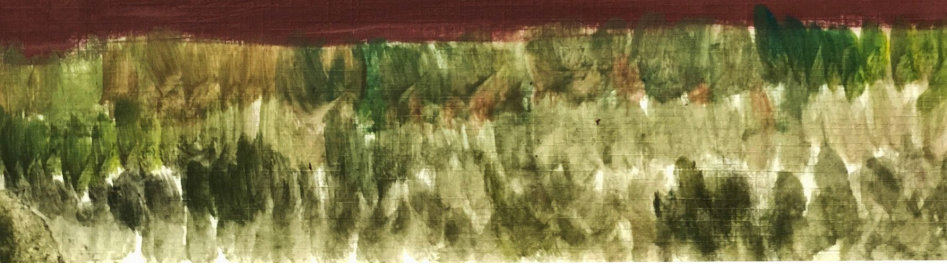


Suddenly, with the
