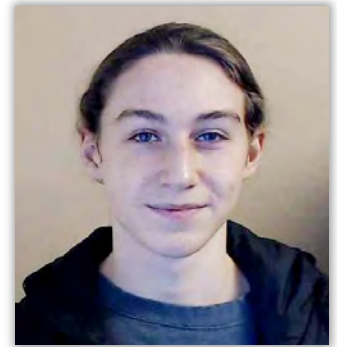

Building Resiliency
